Jindal Centre for the Global South (JCGS) invites reviews of current books on topics relevant to Global South Studies. JCGS book reviews serve the purpose of informing readers of recent publications relating to a broad range of issues and topics affecting Southern countries and peoples. Such publications may address questions involving politics, history, economics, culture, social organization, legal systems, agriculture, the environment, global institutions and systems, justice, and more.

Researchers, faculty, students are welcome to submit proposals for book reviews to JCGS. Proposals should consist of:

1. An APA citation of the book;
2. A brief statement about the book's significance to Global South Studies
3. A brief summary of the reviewing author's background and interest in the book.

Authors of accepted proposals will be invited to write a book review that is no more than 1,000 words in length. Reviews must include:

1. An APA citation of the book
2. A brief overview of the book's primary themes and perspectives
3. A critical analysis of the book's coherence and significance that considers the strengths and weaknesses, scholarly rigor, soundness of presentation, fulfillment of stated objectives, and relevance to the field
4. References, if applicable
5. A one-sentence bio of the reviewing author.

Manuscripts must be formatted using the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (6th ed.) and submitted by email to Jindal Centre for the Global South (jcgs@jgu.edu.in).
