CURRICULUM AND PEDAGOGY

► The curriculum offers a mix of theoretical, practical, and methodological courses. The curriculum comprises of core and elective courses on designing, implementing and evaluating public policies. A range of electives offers opportunity to specialise in specific policy sectors such as health, urban development, land and environment, etc. Students are required to successfully complete 80 credits, spread over 4 semesters, which includes writing a dissertation or undertake a capstone project.

SPECIAL OPTIONS TAILORED TO DIFFERENT APTITUDES

► Jindal School of Government and Public Policy gives its students the choice of undertaking a capstone project, or write a research-based dissertation with faculty guidance, or complete two additional elective courses, in the fourth semester. Students undertaking capstone Projects must work for at least 12 to 15 weeks on a project or assignment given to them by carefully chosen client organisations. Capstone students are expected to deploy their knowledge and skills for the benefit of their client organisation, unlike internships which are primarily learning opportunities.. The likelihood of regular employment with capstone client institutions is high, depending on how well the student does. Students taking up the dissertation option cultivate special skills which are in great demand in a world that is moving towards more evidence-based policymaking. Students taking up additional courses, in lieu of capstone or dissertation, specialise in chosen policy areas, enhancing both range and depth of relevant knowledge.

JOB PLACEMENTS

MAPP Students are equipped to work in the development and policy sectors. Our students have embarked on a successful career in the UNDP, World Health Organisation (Geneva), NITI Ayog, Centre for Policy Research, PRATHAM, Teach for India, Observer Research Foundation, CUTS-Jaipur Public Policy Division; Centre for Public Policy Research (Kochi), Centre for Budget and Government Accountability (CBGA), Centre for Budget and Policy Studies (CBPS), Public Affairs Centre (Bangalore). They have also received Prime Minister's Rural Development Fellowships and Legislative Assistants to Members of Parliament (LAMP) Fellowship.

INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Students are required to complete two to three Guided Internship Programmes with a wide range of institutions.

JSGP has a dedicated team of faculty and staff to assist students with obtaining internships, in both India and abroad, as per students' preferences and interests.
