Bio of Speaker

Dr. Naresh Singh is currently special adviser on sustainability at the Toronto Centre for Global Leadership in Financial Supervision. He has more than 3 decades of post Ph.D. international development experience in more than 50 countries. He was a Director General and acting Vice President at CIDA; Program Director at the International Institute for Sustainable Development (IISD); Principal Adviser on Poverty and Sustainable Livelihoods at UNDP and Executive Director of the UN Commission on Legal Empowerment of the Poor; among several other high-profile positions. He has also been visiting scholar/professor at several Universities in North America, India and the Caribbean and is widely published.

Abstract

The talk will review the risks posed by climate change to various actors in the financial system including investors and consumers as well as the risks posed by the financial system to exacerbate climate change. It will then discuss the role of financial regulatory agencies such as central banks and insurance and pension regulators to reduce such risks and maintain financial stability in the face of the climate emergency. Green finance will be considered as important strategy in this context.
