## **Using the borderlands for peacebuilding? A case study from United Nation Buffer Zone in Cyprus**

#### **Bio of Speaker**

Dr. Birte Vogel is a Lecturer Peace and Conflict Studies at the Humanitarian and Conflict Response Institute, University of Manchester. She is Assistant Editor of the Taylor and Francis journal Peacebuilding and the Co-Investigator on the AHRC funded project "The art of peace: Interrogating community devised arts-based peacebuilding". Her academic interest is mainly on the interface between international and local approaches to peace. In addition to the arts, Birte mainly works on projects looking at the intersection of (everyday) economics and peace. Her recent co-edited book "Economies of Peace: Economy Formation Processes in Conflict-Affected Societies" was published with Routledge (2019). She was previously involved in a EU FP7 funded project 'Cultures of Governance and Conflict Resolution in India and Europe' (2011-213). Dr. Birte Vogel is currently Director of Teaching at the Humanitarian and Conflict Response Institute (HCRI). She holds a PhD in Humanitarianism and Conflict Response from Manchester, an MLitt in Peace and Conflict Studies from the University of St Andrews (Scotland), as well as a Bachelor degree in Economics and Political Science from the University of Münster (Germany).
