**Akansha Rastogi** is Senior Curator, Programming and Exhibitions at the Kiran Nadar Museum of Art. Her curatorial projects include *Hangar for the Passerby* (2017), *Enactments and each passing day* (co-curated, 2016), *An Unfinished Portrait: Vignettes from the KNMA Collection* (co-curated, 2014), *Zones of Contact: Propositions on the Museum* (co-curated, 2013) and the *Inhabiting the Museum* performance series (2011-15) at KNMA. She is a recipient of IFA Research grant to document and study exhibition histories of Indian modern and contemporary art, Inlaks-ISCP Curatorial residency, and IFA-Khoj curatorial grant and residency. She is part of an artist collective WALA that engages with performance art and community art projects.

### Abstract:

*Imagine an incline. Each point on the incline as a place. To stay against gravity even though for a brief duration. Imagine the Fall.*

Taking clues and ideas from the ongoing exhibition 'Hangar for the Passerby' at the Kiran Nadar Museum of Art, this lecture will present an assemblage of different intensities of working together, of collectivities, collaborative artistic practices, and moments of transference across various generations of artists and artist-groups. Scanning through and colliding a range of art events and durations, it will offer a recit, a telling of an exceptional event that has happened and is also yet to happen, and think through the figure of the Passerby as an itinerant.
