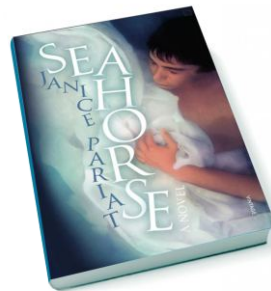
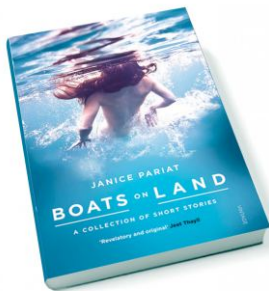

Janice Pariat is the author of *Boats on Land: A Collection of Short Stories* and *Seahorse: A Novel*. She was awarded the Young Writer Award from the Sahitya Akademi and the Crossword Book Award for Fiction in 2013. She studied English Literature at St Stephen's College, Delhi, and History of Art at the School of Oriental and African Studies, London. Her work—including art reviews, book reviews, fiction and poetry—has featured in a wide selection of national magazines and newspapers. In 2014, she was the Charles Wallace Creative Writing Fellow at the University of Kent, UK.

Janice published her first novel, *Seahorse*, in 2014. Her novella *The Nine Chambered-Heart* is out with HarperCollins India (November 2017), forthcoming with HarperCollins UK in May 2018, and is being translated for publication into six languages including Italian, Spanish, French, and German. Currently, she lives in New Delhi with a cat of many names.
